



The MNOLG and Toa CD animations of the legend of Mata Nui both have the same sequence of events. Makuta's shadow spreads, Mata Nui *falls over*, the stones (Matoran) get jumbled, Mata Nui (for some reason) *sinks into* the sand so that his face remains above the surface. In the Toa CD, the stones gather on his face, like the Matoran of Metru Nui migrated to the island of Mata Nui.

UPDATE:



In the movie *Legends of Metru Nui*, at the moment when the Great Cataclysm occurs, the twin suns "close" as if they were eyes. The positions of the twin suns on Mata Nui have always been identified as Naho Bay and a frozen lake in Ko-Wahi. A common misconception used to be that the Mangai volcano was one of the suns, but that was corrected. Why was that important? Because Ko-Wahi and Ga-Wahi are both in the north of Mata Nui and oppose each other latitudinally. In other words, they are where eyes would be if Mata Nui were a face.
