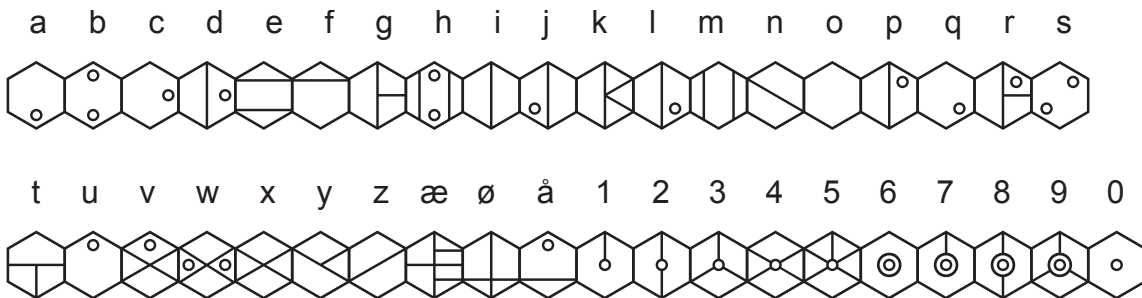


The 2 new Bionicle Proto Fonts for use in 2006 are now ready.  
Here are a few tips for using the fonts.

**Bionicle ProtoFont 2** is a simple monospaced font. Upper and lower case are identical, just like in the original Bionicle font. Only letters and numbers - no punctuation:

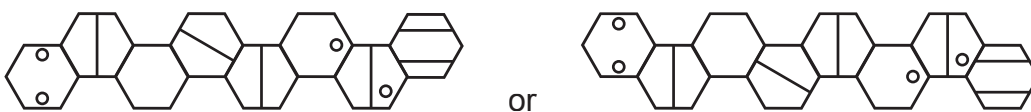


**Bionicle ProtoFont 1** is more sophisticated.

The hexagonal characters fit between each other like cells in a honey comb. But in order to achieve this you *must* alternate between upper and lower case characters. If you just key in “BIONICLE” or “bionicle” it will look like this:



you must input “bloNiCIE” or “BiOnIcLe” to make it look like this:



Unfortunately with this font the numbers present a minor problem.

The reason is, that the “Upper case characters” assigned to the numbers on the keyboard are not the *same* in all countries.

Therefore **Bionicle ProtoFont 1** appears in two versions in your font menu: “*BionicleProOneHiNum*” and “*BionicleProOneLoNum*”

So when writing NUMBERS you must alternate between these two fonts instead of alternating between upper and lower case characters.

The whole **Bionicle ProtoFont 1** looks like this (if you start with a lower case):
